



Identification & Assessment of Victims of Trafficking and Commercial Sexual Exploitation

Course Objectives

Identify the factors that contribute to the commercial sexual exploitation of children.

- Identify the warning signs of a child who is at-risk of being sexually exploited or who is currently being exploited, including understanding the language of “the game.”
- Effective tools in the identification and assessment of victims of trafficking including successfully completing trafficking practice assessments.
- Discuss the business aspect of human trafficking and the commercial sexual exploitation.
- Define human trafficking and the commercial sexual exploitation of children and how they are related.
- Identify the resources both nationally and locally available to intervene, assess and treat those affected by the commercial sexual exploitation of children.

This course will provide a broad overview of human trafficking, focusing on the commercial sexual exploitation of children and its different forms. In addition, the course will provide a background to understand the many factors that contribute to the recruitment and ongoing victimization of young people by traffickers. The identification and assessment of victims is addressed and the session concludes with a focus on appropriate and effective responses and available resources.
