SCHOOL READINESS ACTIVITIES • • •

Early intervention for disadvantaged children is economically efficient and produces higher returns than remedial programs to help children succeed. The benefits of high quality preschool continue into adulthood, according to the High/Scope Perry Preschool Study, among other studies, which has followed participants in a high-quality preschool program for more than 50 years.

The Preschool Services Department (PSD) has aligned School Readiness Goals with the curriculum, Desired Results Developmental Profile (DRDP) Outcomes, Parent Surveys, Early Childhood Environmental Rating Scale (ECERS) and Classroom Assessment Scoring System (CLASS). The Head Start Approach to School Readiness encompasses three major frameworks that include: school readiness for parents and families, infants/toddlers, and preschoolers. These frameworks provide the foundation for implementing systemic and integrated child development services and family

engagement efforts that lead to school readiness for young children and families.

PSD collects and analyzes data three times a year from children's DRDP assessment, Parent Survey, CLASS, and ECERS to complete and update the agency School Readiness Goals. The report is shared with PSD Management, the Policy Council, and Shared Governance Board, as well as site staff and parents.

PSD ensures that children and their families are prepared for transition into kindergarten by coordinating with local school districts and other relevant agencies. Activities held during the year related to Kindergarten transition include:

- Visiting local Kindergarten classrooms
- Inviting Kindergarten teachers to parent meetings
- Facilitating informational Transition Workshops for Parents
- Reviewing the local school district's Kindergarten enrollment packet with parents
- Offering School-to-Home activities to prepare children for transition



EARLY HEAD START







The Early Head Start (EHS) program was established to assist pregnant women, infants and toddlers to age 3. EHS is designed to assist with enhancing:

- Children's physical, social, emotional and intellectual development
- Access for pregnant women to comprehensive prenatal and postpartum care
- Parent education about their child's development
- Parent's efforts to fulfill their parental roles and move towards self-sufficiency

In addition, the EHS program promotes healthy prenatal outcomes, enhances the development of infants and toddlers, and promotes healthy family functioning.



HISTORY







Head Start is a program of the United States
Department of Health and Human Services
that focuses on assisting low-income and
disadvantaged families and children. The
program was created in 1965 as part of President
Lyndon Johnson's war on poverty. The program
was designed to help break the cycle of poverty
by providing comprehensive services that would
meet the emotional, health, nutritional and
psychological needs of preschool children from
low-income and disadvantaged families.



HEAD START SUCCESS STORY!

In September 2013, my son enrolled in preschool at Citrus Head Start. Like many other mothers, I transported my child from home to preschool and did some house chores until it was time to pick him up. In October, the Site Supervisor had asked me if I was interested in joining the Pathways to Success Apprenticeship Program. I declined the offer believing it was something I did not want to participate in and join. The Site Supervisor provided me a handbook and I went home. After reviewing the handbook, I came back the next day and told her that I was in fact very interested in the program. I completed the required paperwork and waited for my welcome letter with my orientation date to arrive in the mail. By the end of November, I had completed the program orientation, completed my TB test, and started the program gave me the extra push I needed to go back and enroll in school. Preschool Services paid for all my books and registration fees, and provided me with a guaranteed slot in both classes. Fast forward to December 2014, I completed my 180 program hours as a Teacher Aide and was finishing up my second semester of school. During this time, I made many friends and connections while attending school

and in December I received a call from the colleges Child Development Center offering me a job as a Student Worker. This job would allow to me continue going to school, therefore I gladly accepted.

I'm writing this because I think it's important for parents to understand the value of the Apprenticeship Program and how it was beneficial to me. I don't think I would have been able to come all this way or obtain a job without all the help and effort from the Citrus Head Start staff. I'm beyond grateful to the Citrus Head Start staff for opening their doors and welcoming me with open arms. Don't be afraid to ask about this program, it opens up a lot of doors, and it's truly an amazing experience working with teachers, staff, and more importantly the children in the community. - Nicole Williams
