Transitional Assistance

Who May Be Eligible for Medi-Cal

Individuals who are potentially eligible for Medi-Cal include those who are:

- Children up to age 19
- Adults 19 and older
- Pregnant
- In a skilled nursing or intermediate care home
- Refugees (limited time frame)

Citizenship/Immigration Requirements

To receive full-scope Medi-Cal benefits, citizens/immigrants may be requested to provide an original or certified copy of:

- Birth certificates, or
- Other acceptable proof of citizenship/immigration paperwork.

Those who are unable to provide proof may be eligible for restricted Medi-Cal to cover:

- Pregnancy, and
- Emergency services

California Residency

Proof of California residency may be required to receive benefits under Medi-Cal Programs, such as:

- Valid California driver license
- Utility bill
- Rent receipt
- Mortgage statement
- Pay stub from California employer

Income Limits

As of 2016 income limits for some Medi-Cal programs are as follows:

Property Limits

Property limits for some Medi-Cal programs are as follows:

Persons in Family	Property Limit
1	\$2,000
2	\$3,000
3	\$3,150
4	\$3,300
5	\$3,450
6	\$3,600

Note: Under some Medi-Cal programs the principle residence and one vehicle are exempt.

Special Programs

There are special programs for individuals who:

- Are enrolled in the Adoption Assistance Program
- Are in Foster Care
- Have breast and cervical cancer
- Are minors in need of confidential treatment for drug and alcohol abuse, sexually transmitted diseases, sexual abuse, pregnancy, family planning and mental illness
- Have tuberculosis (citizens and documented immigrants only)
- Have Medicare (for the payment of the Medicare premium)
- Have had an organ transplant in the previous 2 years who need anti-rejection medication
