SUPPORTING PARENTS IN THEIR PARENTING ROLE

PURPOSE:

To enhance the parent's role as the primary educator of their children within the home environment.

POLICY:

Grantees and delegate agencies operating home-based program options must build upon the principles of adult learning to assist, encourage, and support parents as they foster the growth and development of their children.

REFERENCE:

Head Start Performance Standards Performance Standards 1304.40(E)(3)

PROCEDURE:

The Generalist will work with Home Visitors to set an appointment with the home base parent.

- 2. The Home Base Visitor and Generalists will introduce parent to the Head Start mission and his/her role in assisting families to meet their goals, identify their strengths, and to expand their interests.
- 3. Before leaving the home, the Home Base Visitor and Generalist will provide parents with:
 - a. Information about the Family Learning Center, calendar of events and any other pertinent information that will help parents feel integrated into the Head Start Program.
 - b. Phone number to the Family Learning Center
 - c. Flyers of upcoming Head Start events.
 - d. Generalist Business card or contact letter (name, title, and phone)
- 4. When parent is ready, the Home Visitor will set a time and date with parent to begin the FPA process.
